<u>Snack</u>

I have been approached by several parents who have asked about children bringing in a snack to school. So, I thought it would be useful to clarify. Children in the infants, Reception to Year 2, will be provided free snack through the Government Fruit Scheme. We are hoping this will be in place within the next two weeks. We are happy for parents to send in a piece of fruit or vegetable snack in the meantime and for children in Year 3-6 to also bring in a piece of fruit or vegetable sticks for snack. Breakfast bars or other processed foods are not acceptable.

Please can you bring donations in on either Wednesday 12th or Thursday 13th October.
