## Bingham Belief

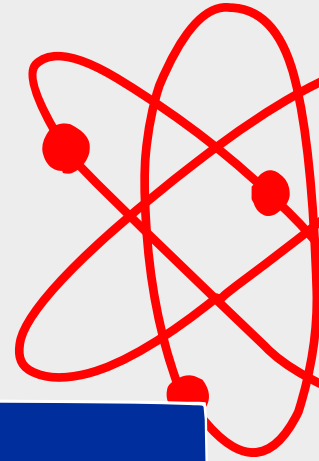
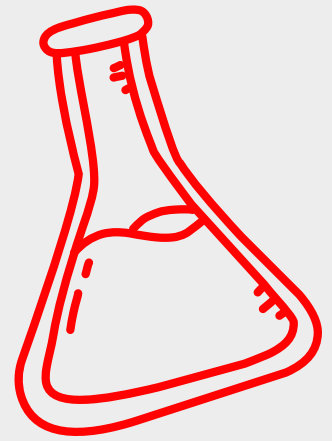

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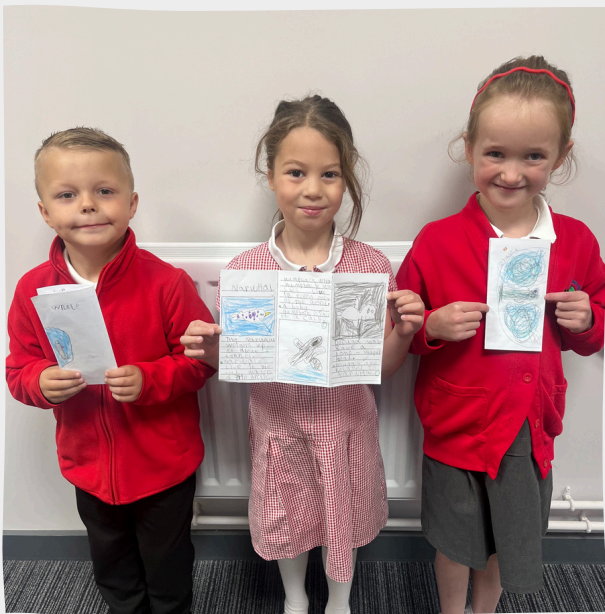


# ROBIN CLASS (EYFS)



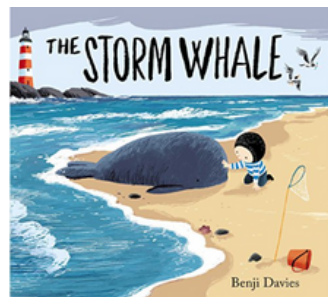
EYFS have been using Bee Bots to look at direction this week. They also used treasure maps.

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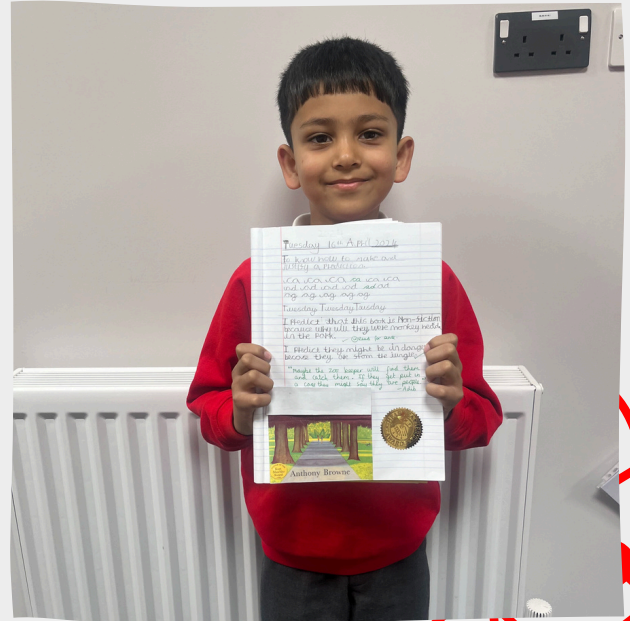
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# KINGFISHER CLASS (Y3&4)
