# Bingham Primary School and Nursery

Dear Parents and Carers.

We are already in our fourth week at school, and I am extremely proud of all the children who have settled into school life. This is an incredible achievement as many of our children came without knowing any of their classmates or staff. Each week the school grows with new pupils, which we are delighted to welcome into our school family.

## **Uniform**

I would like to politely remind parents that we have a compulsory school uniform policy. We encourage our children to wear uniform because it creates a sense of belonging and promotes the ethos of the school. Uniform with the school logo can be purchased from mapac - details available on the school website. Please note, there is no expectation that parents are required to purchase uniform with a logo. We are happy for children to wear a plain red sweatshirt or cardigan, with a white polo-shirt and either grey trousers or skirt/ pinafore in Years one to six. In Nursery and Reception, children should be wearing the same white polo shirt and red jumpers or cardigan with grey jogging shorts or bottoms. Please can you ensure that uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name. Any discarded uniform unlabelled will be kept for two weeks in the school office and then placed into the pre-loved uniform collection to be resold. Please inform class teachers at the earliest opportunity, should your child misplace or lose their uniform and we will endeavour to find the item and return to you accordingly.

#### <u>Jewellery</u>

Jewellery should not be worn to school, as this presents a health and safety risk during the school day. As such, we request that children do not wear jewellery, unless there is a medical reason. Children may only wear stud earrings; however, these will need to be removed prior to your child being allowed to take part in PE. Staff are no longer allowed to help children remove or insert earrings, nor are they allowed to have children participate in PE with tape over their earrings. We would request that if pupils were to have their ears pierced, then this be undertaken during the first week of the Summer Holidays, so that they can remove their earrings on return to school. Children learning to tell the time are permitted to wear an analogue watch, however apple watches or similar digital devices are not allowed in school.

## **School Photographs**

On Wednesday, we have a school photographer coming in to take individual photographs and would request that all children are in their correct uniform.
