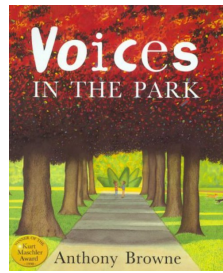
Term Overview:

Maths

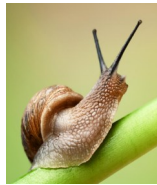
This term, we will be focusing on fractions and decimals, money, time, shape and statistics.

Our History topic for this half term is 'Crime and punishment'. We will be learning all about how punishments have changed, from the Roman



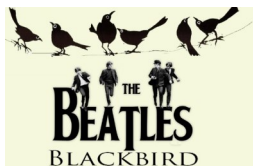
Art

In music we are going to be learning 'Blackbird' by the Beatles and exploring how the Beatles helped to reshape Western pop music in the 1960s.



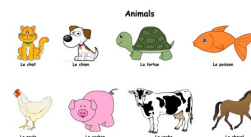
RE
