The children were amazing in all of the performances and all children took part. It can be daunting for children to perform to an audience but they did it with smiling faces. Thank you to all who came.



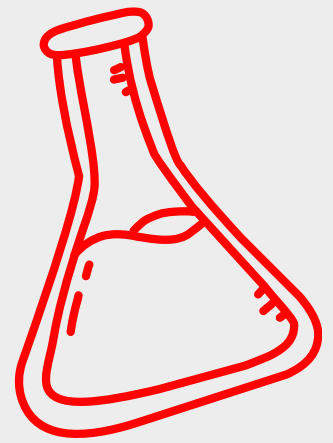

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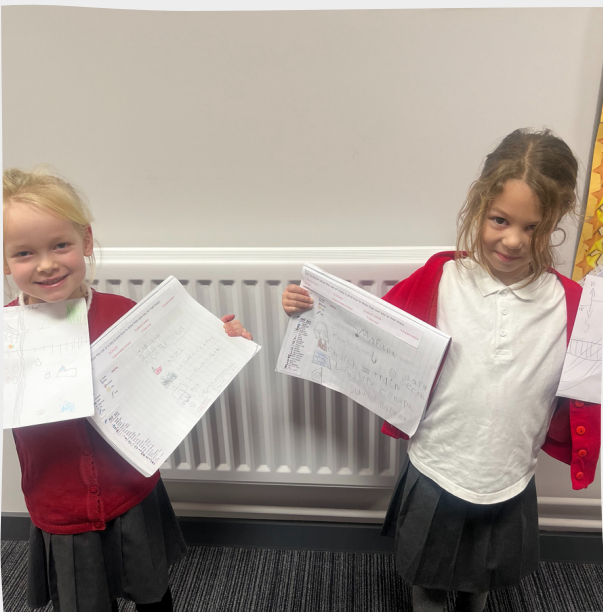
ROBIN CLASS (EYFS)

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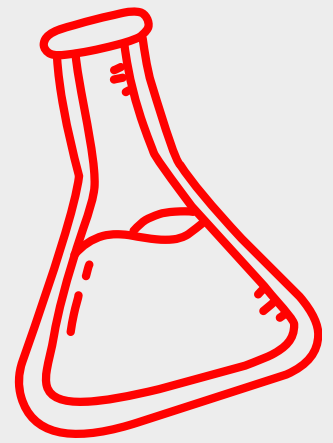
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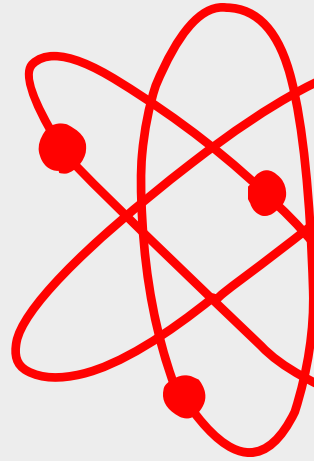


CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER AND HOMEWORK



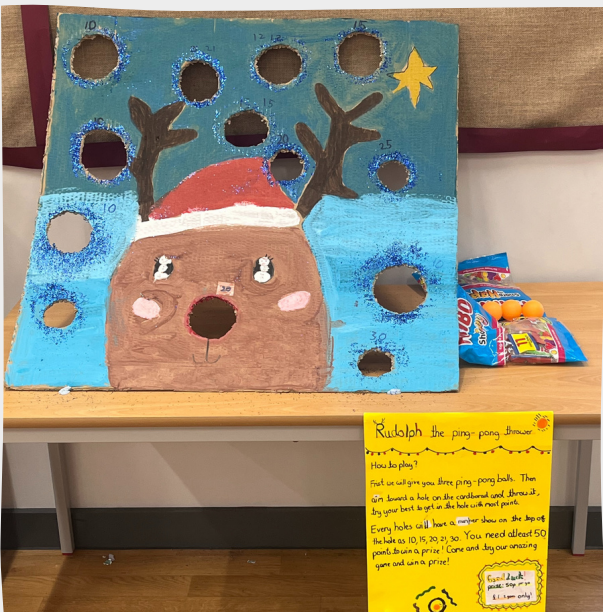
As mentioned before, your feedback is important to us. We have a suggestion box in our Reception, which is checked weekly.
