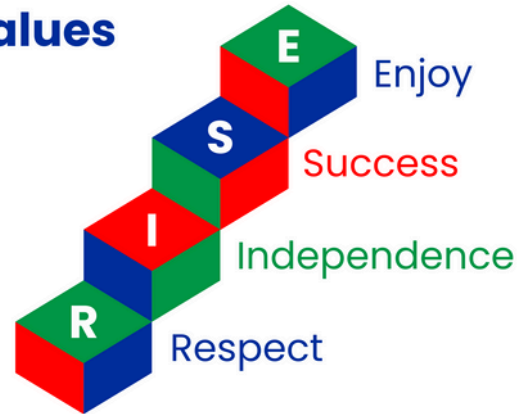

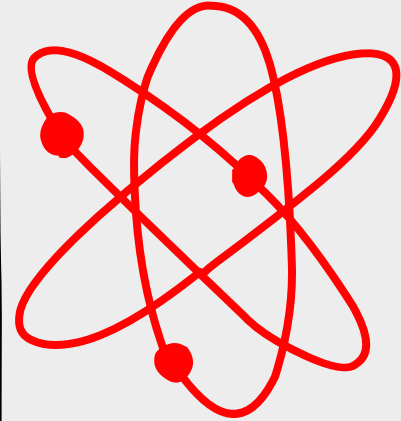
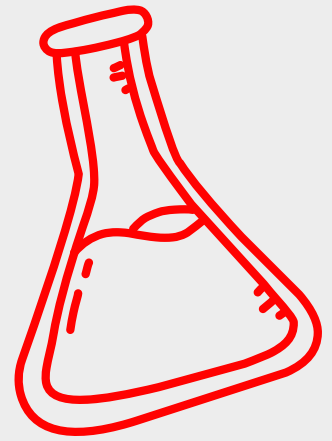
Our Behaviours

Year 1 have been using mirrors to sketch their faces and looking at greater and less than in Maths this week



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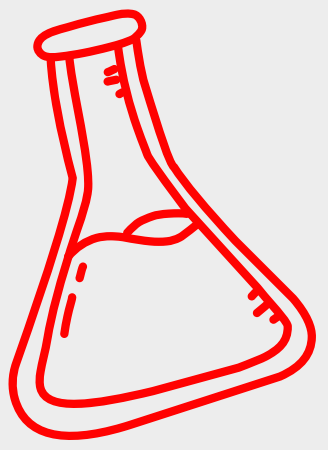
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BARN OWL CLASS (YEAR 2)

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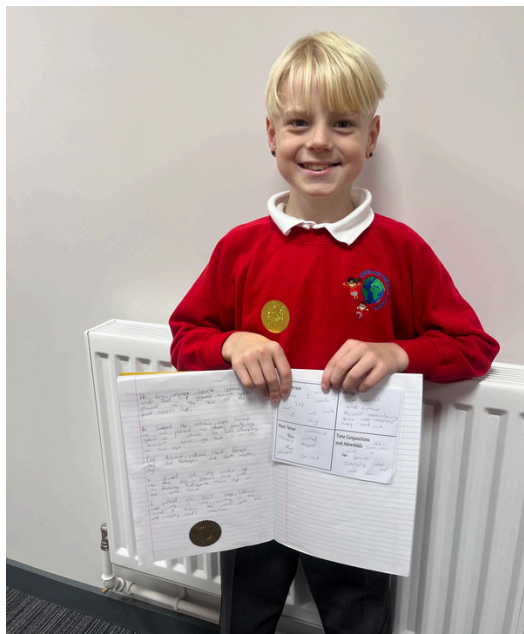
KINGFISHER CLASS (Y3&4)

The pupils are really enjoying their History unit about the Egyptians. They spent this week getting into character and recording each other speak. They have also written diary entries.



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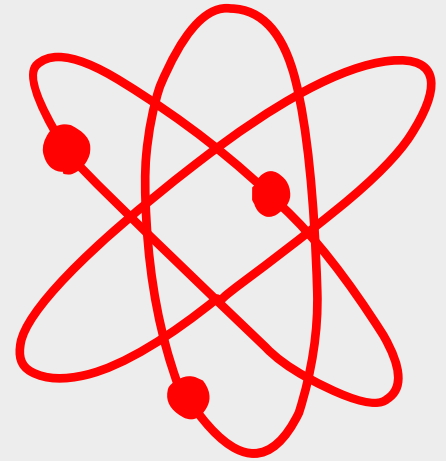
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FAMILY BINGO

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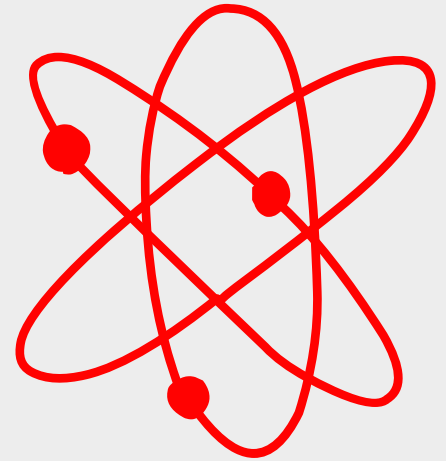
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SCHOOL COUNCIL
