Birth Certificates

Mrs Orton still has outstanding gaps in some children's files, as we have not seen their original birth certificate. If you have not yet managed to bring this into school, please can you do so as a matter of urgency.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones are not allowed in school. If your child is in KS2 and walks home alone and you wish them to have use of a mobile phone for security they are permitted to bring their phone to the school office on arrival, to be kept safe during the day and collect when they go home.

Water Bottles

I have spoken to staff this week to confirm that all children have been provided with a Bingham Water Bottle. These are to be kept in school during the week and sent home on a Friday for parents to wash. They must then be returned empty on Monday mornings.

Packed Lunches/ Nut Allergy

The information below is in adherence with the government guidance for school lunches. We encourage healthy lunches and teach children in school about a balanced diet.

Items not permitted in packed lunches:

- Nuts, including Nutella.
- Fizzy drinks
- Chocolate bars
- Sweets

We now have a child in school who has a nut allergy. This means that we will be a **nut-free school** and so I would ask parents to ensure that no nuts are sent into school in packed lunches.
