Term: Summer 2



Topic Overview: This term we are going to be learning all about the jungle. We will be exploring the jungle and meeting lots of different jungle animals. We may even get to see some animals in real life!

Communication, Language and Literacy (CLL)

Through our topic work, we are going to be exploring lots of different fiction and non-fiction texts related to the jungle. We will be writing setting descriptions, poems and even our own stories!

Through our phonics we are going to continue practising the digraphs and trigraphs we have learnt so far and reading even longer words!



Understanding the world (UfW)

This term our topic is all about the jungle. We will be learning all about rainforests and what lives there, including the animals. We will find out about how animals grow and how we can look after our world even better.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

In music, we are going to continue exploring different music. We will be creating our own music and performing it proudly and with appropriate volume. We will be celebrating our friends' performances!

In Art and Design, we are going to be applying the skills we have been learning through the year. We will be using a variety of materials, tools and techniques to make our creations linked to our jungle theme.



Maths

In our maths work this term we are going to be learning all about patterns. We will be learning to double and half by sharing into equal groups and also to visualise simple models made out of cubes and other objects. We are continuing to use our numbers to 20 to solve addition and subtraction problems.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

In PSED we will be learning about keeping our bodies healthy and happy as we grow from a baby to an adult, knowing names for our body parts and talking about our fun and fears of getting ready for Year 1.



Physical Development (PD)

This term, we will be working on our balance and coordination skills through the topic of 'gymnastics'. We will develop skills of balancing, jumping and landing safely, rolling and using apparatus safely. We will also be continuing to work on our independence by starting to get changed for PE in preparation for Year 1! This will happen in the last 4 weeks of term.
